

Yerington Information page:

1. The main pit area is slightly limited. We ask that you be mindful of your pit area. Pitting is ok on both sides of the course, but you must keep 25 feet between the track and your RV or trailer. also ask that you save the top area, near the RV park for semi's and very large truck and trailers. There will be a pitting area located n the south end of the main pit area that runs from east to west. Large trailers and RV's should not pit in this area and anyone pitting must pay attention to the sprinkler heads. ,,
2. Main pit location: 38.9915136, -119.2084734 . From Golden Gate gas station, Head north on US-95 ALT. Turn Left (west) onto Burch Dr. Follow Burch drive for 1.6 miles. Turn right at VORRA markers and follow into pits. (NOTE: this access into main pits will only be open until 9am Friday morning, after that you will need to follow markers up towards the RV park)
3. Main Pit to pit 4 39°01'42.47"N 119°15'36.62"W. Head north on US-95 ALT and turn Left onto Luzier Ln. Follow Luzier Ln for two miles, turn right onto Mason pass road for 4.3 miles this will end up at Checkpoint 4.
4. Main pit to Pit 1 39°04'11.67"N 119°19'25.14"W and Pit 3 39°05'06.15"N 119°16'24.52"W. Head north on US-95 ALT. Turn Left onto Campbell Ln for 5.6 miles, Warning! This road goes through Yerington Indian Reservation. Follow the speed limits!!! Pit 3 is on your right. Pit 1 is 4.1 miles West from Pit 3 on Campbell Ln. There will be a ton of 2-way traffic. Watch your speeds. Chasers can make it from Checkpoint 2 to Checkpoint 4 with plenty of time. I have personally seen roll overs and head on's on this road during races. Additionally, the racecourse parallels the access road for about one mile. There is no stopping on this part of the road. You must pit in the pit area.
5. Pro Pit, Checkpoint 3 39.1574292, -119.2465655 will be accessible if needed. From Pit B head east and turn Left at Y. Pro pit access will be marked with Race arrows.
6. Youth awards will take place at the award ceremony on Sunday inside the Yerington Convention center.
7. Qualifying, youth tech and registration, as well as poker run card pickup starts at 7 am. You will need to sign up online. You'll still need to come and get your transponder and check in. Qualifying drivers meeting and the youth drivers meeting starts at 9am. All youth racers, bring your race car to registration. Following the meeting, we will line up in the pit area. We will then parade from the pit area to the start line. The start line will be at the north end of the pit lane.
8. Poker run card pick up's start at 7 am and run till 9am. Poker run card pick up will pause until 12pm during the poker run drivers meeting at 12pm. The poker run starts at 12:30pm. You may not leave the start line after 13:30. You must have a poker run card in the vehicle to take place on the poker run. Cards will be asked to be seen at each card draw. You will be asked to leave to race course without a card. Cards will be drawn as follows, Card 1, Start line. Card 2, Pit 1. Card

3, Pit 3. Card 4 Sinclair Gas station Address is 423 N. Main St. Yerington NV 89447. Card 5 will be drawn at the Cellar Bar located inside the Dini's casino. You will leave your Poker card with the Cellar bar. Please be sure we can read your name and phone number. Poker run winners will be announced at the Drivers meeting. Best card wins \$500.00. Be sure all cards are submitted by 6pm.

9. Registration will take place inside the Yerington convention center between Dinis casino
10. You MUST first go through registration, grab your racer packet and then head through tech
11. Tech and registration will once again take place in Downtown Yerington. You will enter the Tech area on the south side on Main Street near the Yerington Inn. The tech line will head North, and we ask that you park your vehicle on main street after you have been teched.
12. You may drive your race to and from Tech with an escort. Be sure to obey all traffic laws!!!
- 13.** Driver's meeting at 6:30 in the Yerington Convention center.
14. Parade down main street at 7:30. There will be an escort back to Main pit as needed.
15. Awards will take place Sunday morning at 10am inside the Yerington Convention Center
16. Course notes. This is as close to the Original Yerington course that we will ever get. The first 6 miles are tight and technical. Take your time, and if caught get out of the way asap.
 1. At Race mile (RM) 6 there is a ridgeline that at times become off camber. Watch this area.
 2. At RM 8, there is left turn down into a rocky canyon. Lots of Maytag size rocks to take you out.
 3. You will make full stops at pits 1,3,4 and start finish.
 4. All checkpoints and start finish will have a 25mph zones. Most will be marked with large 25mph signs, speed zone signs, or smaller red speed zone signs. These zones will be on the GPS download. It is your responsibility to be within speed limits in these zones.
 5. Speeding was heavily penalized at the last race. Speeding will continue to a major topic, and we have purchased additional radar guns to have throughout the racecourse.
 6. RM 23 becomes "skinny" with a decent cliff on the left side. Take your time.
 7. RM 25 there is a lakebed to the right. DO NOT take the lakebed. Anyone caught on the lakebed will receive an automatic DQ.

8. After Pro Pit/pit 2 you'll get into "comfortably Numb". It's ruff, have fun!
9. Just after Pit 3, RM 41, the racecourse parallel's the access road. There is no stopping or spectating in this area!
10. RM 51.5. Lots of mining going on here. There is a marker in the middle of the road over a crest. Its marked with a danger and a cone. Take your time through this section.
11. RM 54-58 are tight, somewhat sketchy and slippery. There are a few tight corners all while coming down hill. There is also a few wash outs marked with dangers. Be mindful of this road
12. This course is fast! We expect the fast cars to average 55mph easy.
13. Pit race mileage
 1. 18
 2. 33.5
 3. 40.5
 4. 47

All chase crews must monitor their speeds on access roads. These roads will be very busy with two-way traffic
